**Professional Standards and
Competencies for Early Childhood**

Educators (MiPSCs) and the Michigan AEYC Knowledge Center

In Fall of 2025, Michigan adopted a brand-new set of Professional Standards and Competencies for Early Childhood Educators! These new standards replaced the Michigan Core Knowledge and Core Competencies (CKCCs) and are fully aligned with the National Association for the Education of Young Children's (NAEYC) Professional Standards and Competencies. This exciting shift positions Michigan at the forefront of a nationwide movement to unify and elevate the early childhood education profession.

What's Inside the New Framework?

Michigan's new standards include nine key competencies:

- Six standards adopted directly from NAEYC
- Three Michigan-specific standards that reflect the unique needs and priorities of our state's early childhood education system

Together, we are strengthening the foundation of early childhood education – creating consistency, honoring professionalism, and ensuring every child in Michigan has access to high-quality early learning experiences.

Michigan AEYC has launched tools and resources to introduce the field to the new standards and competencies in its [Knowledge Center](#).

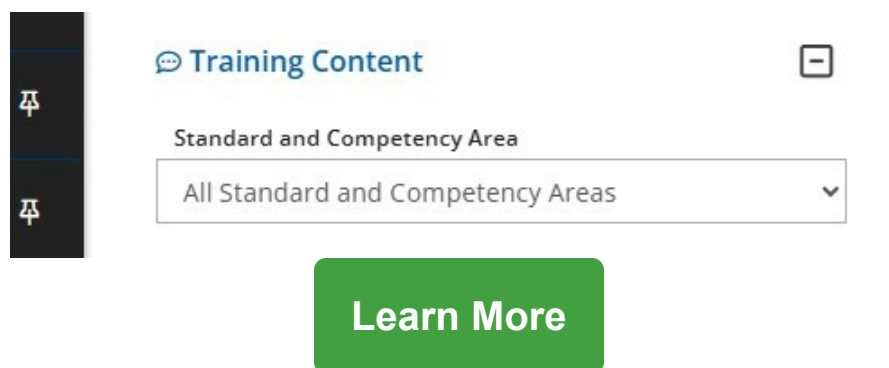
