How to Find Training that offers Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

Are you looking for training that offers Continuing Education Units (CEUs) to support licensing qualifications or maybe you are a certified educator and require State Continuing Education Hours (SCECHs) to maintain your certification. Read on to learn more!

What is a CEU?

Per the Child Care Licensing Technical Assistance (TA) and Consultation Manual for Child Care Centers:

“CEU” means a continuing education unit awarded by an accredited college or university sponsor of continuing education units or state continuing education clock hour awarded by the state board of education.

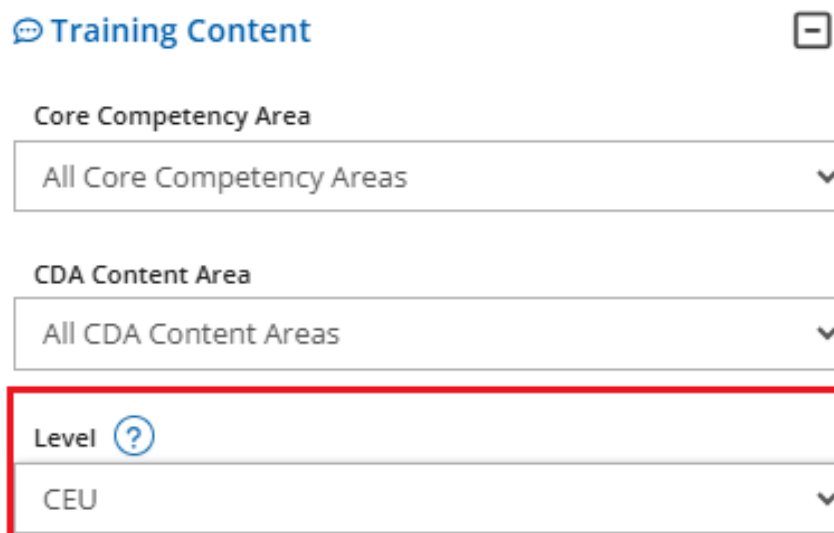
This definition includes **Continuing Education Units (CEUs)** and **State Continuing Education Clock Hours (SCECHs)**.

MiRegistry Approved CEU level training and SCECH qualified training will count toward your total CEUs.

- 10 CEU level training hours = 1 CEU
- 10 SCECH qualified training hours = 1 CEU

How to find CEU level training to count toward CEU requirements:

On the [Statewide Training Calendar](#), filter by **Training Content --> Level --> CEU** and click **Search**.

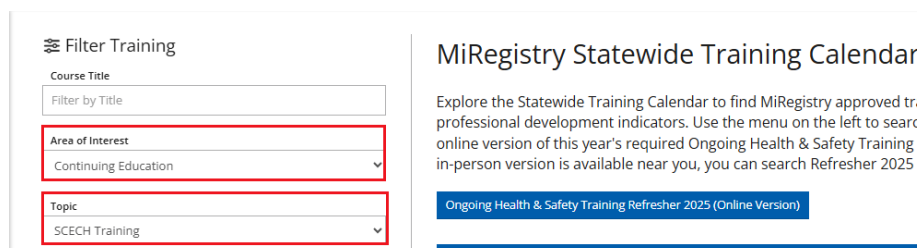

4. Select the "Educator Certification" option from the drop-down menu
5. Enter your Educator Certification and PIC information
6. Click "Save" at the bottom of the page

2. Go to *Topic*
 - a. When you click on the drop down it will default to All Topics, scroll to select the specific Health and Safety course you are looking for from the drop down list.
