Center-Based Providers	Two years after the effective date of this rule May 7, 2027, all training to meet professional development requirements must be approved in MiRegistry*. <i>*"MiRegistry-approved training" means training that is submitted to MiRegistry by a MiRegistry approved trainer or MiRegistry training sponsor organization (TSO) that meets the qualification for approval.</i>	MiRegistry no longer accepts training submitted via certificate dated January 1, 2026 and after. Center-based* and home-based* organizations should begin the process of becoming an approved Training Sponsor Organization (TSO) so they can submit the following types of professional development for approval: • Staff Orientation • Staff meetings • In-house training conducted by non-approved trainers • Training taken outside of MiRegistry from non-approved training sponsors	Starting 5/7/27, all training to meet professional development requirements must be approved in MiRegistry.	MiRegistry policy implemented on January 1st, 2026 will allow ample time for the following before the Child Care Licensing policy takes effect: • All providers to become familiar with MiRegistry approved training* • Center-Based and Home-Based organizations to become approved TSOs • MiRegistry to recruit and support state and national training organizations with becoming approved TSOs <i>*MiRegistry approved training is training found via the MiRegistry Statewide Training Calendar or provided by an organization that has been designated as a TSO.</i>
Home-Based Providers	Two years after the effective date of this rule all training to meet professional development requirements must be approved in MiRegistry*. <i>*"MiRegistry-approved training" means training that is submitted to MiRegistry by a MiRegistry-approved trainer or MiRegistry training sponsor organization (TSO) that meets the qualification for approval.</i>	TSOs submit training directly within the MiRegistry system as courses/events not via certificate. <i>Questions about becoming a TSO? Reach out to support@miregistry.org for TA support.</i> <i>*Center-based providers will still be able to present their training certificates dated prior to 5/7/27 to their licensing consultant for review.</i> <i>*Home-based providers will still be able to present their training certificates prior to 4/27/28 to their licensing consultant for review.</i>	Starting 4/27/28, all training to meet professional development requirements must be approved in MiRegistry.
